Safety Guidelines & Protocols

We are pleased to announce that The Flower Fields will be open beginning March 1 via **ONLINE RESERVATIONS ONLY**. We ask that you help us keep The Flower Fields a safe and healthy place for all by reviewing our Visitor Information & Safety Guidelines prior to your visit.

Important Notice For All Visitors

The Flower Fields has put in place a number of new protocols and processes to help ensure the safety of our staff and visitors. It is important that you read through this information in its entirety before your visit. We're working hard to protect you in the midst of this pandemic, but we'll need you to do your part, too!

COVID-19 SAFETY MEASURES AT THE FLOWER FIELDS

- Touchless ticket and entry system
- Multiple entry and exit points
- Cloth masks or face coverings must be worn over the nose and mouth at all times by all visitors (children under 2 are exempt), volunteers and by all staff members, except when eating or drinking.
- Visitor capacity reduced and controlled at all locations.
- Enhanced cleaning of high-touch surfaces and restrooms throughout the day; hand-sanitizer units have been stationed throughout the property.
- Bring water with you; water fountains are not available.
- Staff & Volunteers are required to pass a daily symptom screening with temperature check.
- A physical distance of 6 feet between yourself and others is required; parties consisting of single households may remain together; children must stay with adults at all times.

PLEASE DO NOT VISIT THE FLOWER FIELDS IF you have been in close contact with someone who has COVID-19 or COVID symptoms or if you have experienced any of the following symptoms in the last 10 days:

- Fever
- Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing
- Chills

NOT DUE TO A CHRONIC CONDITION

- Sore throat
- Headache
- Recent loss of sense of taste or smell
- Muscle aches
- Cough

In accordance with the San Diego County Public Health Order, physical distancing and wearing a face covering is required to help reduce the spread of COVID-19. However, even if all protocols are followed there are increased risks of exposure to COVID-19 any time you visit a public place. The Flower Fields, in alignment with the San Diego County Public Health Order, strongly encourages persons who have active or unstable pre-existing health conditions, to remain at home and not visit The Flower Fields at this time.
